Did you know that there is no expiry date to honey! The edible food remains good forever until used otherwise, like using a wet spoon

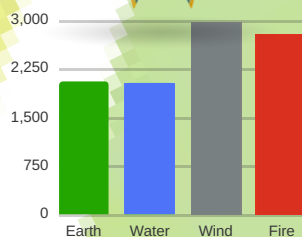
#### Dogs Nose Prints
