Secondary Science Experiment

Year 1
Children in Year 1 is learning about materials. A range of different materials used daily was explored. This activity indicated how knowledgeable and curious children are about their environment. We shall soon be using advanced scientific vocabulary to describe and compare materials.

Year 2
Year 2 is exploring this rocky world! Imagine what this world would be like without rocks. Did you know that soil is formed when rocks break down? The children are exhilarated about this topic and they have been collecting samples of rocks already and they are talking about their different types and textures. They are also linking them to their uses. Join them in this rocky adventure.

Year 3

It was a great experience to do some of the Ancient Greek art works like molding pots, helmets, swords, labyrinths in History. In Mathematics, 2D shapes were our priority.
